## **Configure Client Computer's Internet Explorer To Allow GA Login**

If the Wave is not in the normal local network of the client computer, then Internet Explorer will restrict the running of Java applets normally. These applets are used to to login to and run many Wave administration tasks. To properly access the Wave, it is necessary to first configure the settings of Internet Explorer.

To add the Wave Server to the Internet Explorer Local Intranet group:

1. In Internet Explorer, choose the gear icon and then Internet Options from the menu that appears.
