- 1. On your local Windows PC, to launch Remote Desktop Connection, use one of the following methods:
 - Select **Start** , and then scroll through the alphabetical list on the left (if your Start screen is set to show as full screen, select All apps, and then scroll through the list) and select **Windows Accessories** and then select **Remote Desktop Connection**.



• In the search box on the taskbar, type Remote Desktop Connection, and then select **Remote Desktop Connection**.
